

Professional Code

The college function as per the professional code of UGC, the University, the State government the mother institution for the different professions (Teachers, non-teaching staff)

Teachers should:

- 1) Discharge their professional responsibilities according to the rules and adhere to procedures and methods consistent with their profession in initiating steps through their own institutional bodies and/or professional organizations for change of any such rule determinant to the professional interest.
- 2) Refrain from undertaking any other employment and commitment including private tuitions and coaching classes which are likely to interfere with their professional responsibilities.
- 3) Co-operate in the formulation of policies of the institution by accepting various offices and discharge responsibilities which such office may demand.
- 4) Co –operate through their organizations in the formulation of policies of the other institution and accept offices.
- 5) Co-operate with the authorities for the betterment of the institutions keeping in view the interest and in conformity of the profession.
- 6) Should adhere to the conditions of contract.
- 7) Give and expect due notice before a change of position is made.
- 8) Refrain from availing themselves of leave except on unavoidable grounds and as far as practicable with prior information keeping in view their particular responsibility completion of academic schedule.

Teachers and Non teaching staff:

- 1) Teachers should treat the non teaching staff as colleagues and equal partners in a co-operative undertaking, within every educational institution.
- 2) Teachers should help in the function of joint staff councils covering both teachers and the non teaching staff.
